All the courses and its classes are designed in such a way that they serve the vision and mission statements of the College.

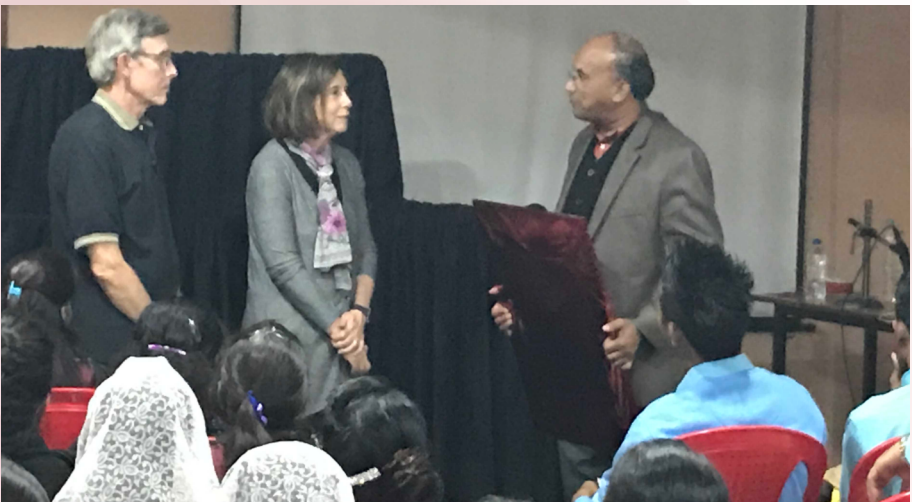
MAIN CHAPEL SERVICE
